



## Answer to Question: Effects of Goodyear Strike

---

● Question: What are the effects of the Goodyear labor dispute on tire production for the M1114 and the M1151?

◆ Answer:

- The Goodyear Tire and Rubber strike began on 5 Oct. Goodyear's salaried employees and union members willing to cross the picket line are producing tires but there is a shortfall. The priority of available tires is to the AOR and new vehicle production destined for the AOR.
- New vehicle production is continuing
  - AMG currently receives Goodyear tires for vehicles destined for the AOR.
  - The remainder of production receives "slave" tires that can be used for moving the vehicles only.
  - The number of tires that can be shipped to AMG could decrease as AOR demand outpaces production of tires.
- To alleviate AOR shortages, TACOM Life Cycle Management Command (LCMC) implemented the follow mitigating actions:
  - 1) No longer filling requirements that are not in support of the AOR.
  - 2) RECAP sites will not receive new tires during the strike.
  - 3) Tires in support of Light Tactical Trailer (LTT) production are being diverted to support the AOR.
- An injunction request under the Taft-Hartley act, a coordinated product from the TACOM LCMC, is currently being staffed thru HQ AMC to HQs DA and then onto OSD.
