Hunter Named as Conferee on Intelligence Reform Legislation

Washington, D.C. – The Speaker of the House today named five Members of Congress, including Armed Services Committee Chairman Duncan Hunter, to represent House Republicans in the Conference Committee on H.R. 10 – The 9/11 Recommendations Implementation Act.
