Dear Mr Chairman:

As directed in the House Armed Services Committee Report Number 107-194, page 294, Capital Investment Program (CIP) for Depot Facilities, the Army was instructed to provide a plan for capital investment in the Army maintenance depots.

Our current CIP process adequately addresses current weapon system requirements. However, during this review process, we discovered our CIP does not address future core requirements and technology infusion in the depot maintenance process. In order to correct this planning shortfall and properly respond to the Congressional request for data, Headquarters, Department of the Army will charter an Integrated Product Team to improve our process and produce a report that addresses the three components of the CIP implementation plan. We plan to complete this plan by March 1, 2003 and forward it to the Committees.
