NOTIFICATION OF THE INTENTION  
TO INITIATE DESIGNS FOR THE FOLLOWING PROPOSED MILITARY  
CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

(10 USC SECTION 2807)

The Department of the Army proposes to authorize the obligation of funds for the design of the following three military construction projects. Unless otherwise noted, the projects submitted herewith are within the Construction Criteria Manual DoD 4270.1-M, dated 1 July 1986 (unpublished), as implemented by the Army.
