Dear Mr. Chairman:

Title 10 USC, Section 2811 (as amended by Public Law 105-85), requires that the Secretary concerned shall submit Congressional notification to the appropriate committees when they plan to carry out a repair project in excess of \$7,500,000. This letter notifies the committee of a repair project to be accomplished at Aliamanu Military Reservation, Hawaii, with a total estimated funded cost of \$12,200,000 using Army Family Housing maintenance and repair funds.

This undertaking involves the repair by replacement of existing, failed or failing secondary electrical distribution system including the laterals. The secondary system was installed in 1970s and has deteriorated from weathering, corrosion and termite infestations. The system is composed of secondary service laterals consisting of insulated aluminum conductors distributed from 61 transformers serving 520 buildings consisting of 2,010 dwelling units.
