The President, under the provisions of Section 601, Title 10, United States Code, has submitted to the Senate the nomination of Rear Admiral (Selectee) Albert M. Calland III, United States Navy, for appointment to the grade of vice admiral.

Rear Admiral (Selectee) Calland is presently serving as Commander, Naval Special Warfare Command. He will be assigned as Associate Director of Central Intelligence for Military Support, Central Intelligence Agency. He is 51 years of age.

This action will not result in the Navy exceeding the number of authorized three-star positions.
