The President, under the provisions of Section 601, Title 10, United States Code, has submitted to the Senate the nomination of Rear Admiral Jonathan W. Greenert, United States Navy, for appointment to the grade of vice admiral.

Rear Admiral Greenert is presently serving as Deputy and Chief of Staff, United States Pacific Fleet. He will be assigned as Commander, SEVENTH Fleet. He is 50 years of age.

This action will not result in the Navy exceeding the number of authorized three-star positions.

For the information of the Committee, I am enclosing a career resume on Rear Admiral Greenert which includes a summary of his joint duty assignment.
