The President, under the provisions of Section 601, Title 10, United States Code, has submitted to the Senate the nomination of Rear Admiral Charles L. Munns, United States Navy, for appointment to the grade of vice admiral.

Rear Admiral Munns is presently serving as Director, Navy and Marine Corps Intranet, Office of the Assistant Secretary of the Navy (Research, Development and Acquisition). He will be assigned as Commander Submarine Force, United States Atlantic Fleet and Commander, Submarine Allied Command, Atlantic. He is 53 years of age.

This action will not result in the Navy exceeding the number of authorized three-star positions.
