Page 21, line 5, strike “**2660c**” and insert “**2660d**”.

Page 21, after line 4, insert the following new section:

1 **“§ 2660c. Notifications and reports on certain near-**
2 **miss events in National Capital Region**

3 “(a) NOTIFICATIONS.—Not later than one week after
4 the date on which a covered near-miss event occurs, the
5 Secretary of Defense shall submit to the Committees on
6 Armed Services of the House of Representatives and the
7 Senate a notification of such event.

8 “(b) ESTABLISHMENT OF ASSOCIATED DEFINI-
9 TION.—Not later than 60 days after the date of the enact-
10 ment of this section, the Secretary, in coordination with
11 a working group determined appropriate by the Secretary,
12 shall establish a definition of the term ‘close proximity en-
13 counter’ for purposes of this section.

14 “(c) REPORTS.—Not later than 180 days after the
15 date on which the definition under subsection (b) is estab-

1 lished, on a biannual basis thereafter for the following
2 two-year period, and not less frequently than annually
3 thereafter, the Secretary of Defense shall submit to the
4 Committees on Armed Services of the House of Represent-
5 atives and the Senate a report containing, with respect
6 to the period covered by the report—

7 “(1) an identification of the number of covered
8 near-miss events that occurred during such period;

9 “(2) for each such event, an identification of
10 any cause of such event; and

11 “(3) a description any modification to relevant
12 standard operating procedures or other policies of
13 the Department of Defense issued, or planned to be
14 issued, to address such events; and

15 “(4) a description of the status of implementa-
16 tion of any such modification.

17 “(d) COVERED NEAR-MISS EVENT DEFINED.—In
18 this section, the term ‘covered near-miss event’ means a
19 close proximity encounter (as such term is defined pursu-
20 ant to subsection (b)) that—

21 “(1) involves at least one Department of De-
22 fense aircraft; and

23 “(2) occurs in the National Capital Region.”.

Add at the end of the bill the following new section:

1 **SEC. 205. ANNUAL REPORT ON PROFICIENCY FLIGHTS IN**
2 **NATIONAL CAPITOL REGION.**

3 (a) ANNUAL REPORT.—Not later than one year after
4 the date of the enactment of this Act, and annually there-
5 after for each of the two subsequent years, the Secretary
6 of Defense shall submit to Congress a report on the num-
7 ber of Department of Defense proficiency flights that oc-
8 curred in the National Capitol Region during the 12-
9 month period preceding the date of the submission of the
10 report.

11 (b) NATIONAL CAPITOL REGION.—In this section,
12 the term “National Capitol Region” has the meaning
13 given such term in section 2655(10) of title 10, United
14 States Code, as added by section 201.

Add at the end of the bill the following new section:

1 **SEC. 205. BRIEFING ON VIRTUAL CONSTRUCTIVE TRAIN-**
2 **ING.**

3 Not later than 180 days after the date of the enact-
4 ment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense shall provide
5 to the congressional defense committees (as such term is
6 defined in section 101(a)(16) of title 10, United States
7 Code) a briefing on the feasibility of using virtual con-
8 structive training to optimize the amount of in-air training
9 used by the Armed Forces.



**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE
NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 7613
OFFERED BY MS. TOKUDA OF HAWAII**

Page 12, line 20, strike “REPORT” and insert “INITIAL REPORT”.

Page 13, line 3, after the period insert the following new sentence: “Such report shall include, for each month during the 12-month period preceding the date of the submission of the report, the actual number of special mission flights flown with ADS-B Out turned off, in whole or in part, within a Class B Mode C veil airspace, disaggregated by special mission activity.”.

Page 13, after line 6, insert the following:

1 “(d) SUBSEQUENT REPORT.—(1) Not later than one
2 year after the date of the submission of the report under
3 subsection (c), the Secretary of Defense shall submit to
4 the congressional defense committees a report that in-
5 cludes, for each month during the 12-month period pre-
6 ceding the date of the submission of the report, the actual
7 number of special mission flights that the Secretary of De-
8 fense flown with ADS-B Out turned off, in whole or in

1 part, within a Class B Mode C veil airspace, disaggregated
2 by special mission activity.

3 “(2) The report under paragraph (1) shall be sub-
4 mitted in unclassified form, but may include a classified
5 annex.”.

Page 16, after line 7, insert the following:

1 “(e) COMPTROLLER GENERAL REVIEW.—(1) The
2 Comptroller General of the United States shall conduct
3 a review of the efficacy of the manned rotary wing aviation
4 safety management systems established or updated pursu-
5 ant to subsection (a). Such review shall include—

6 “(A) an assessment of the extent to which the
7 Secretary has implemented the requirements under
8 subsection (a);

9 “(B) an assessment of the extent to which the
10 Secretary has developed an approach to identify and
11 mitigate any risks in implementing subsection (a);
12 and

13 “(C) any other matters the Comptroller General
14 determines are relevant.

15 “(2) Not later than September 1, 2027, the Comp-
16 troller General shall provide to the congressional defense
17 committees a briefing on the preliminary findings of the
18 review required under paragraph (1). The Comptroller
19 General shall provide to such committees the final results

1 of such review in a mutually agreed upon format and time-
2 frame.”.

Page 21, line 5, strike “**2660c**” and insert “**2660d**”.

Page 21, after line 4, insert the following new section:

1 **“§ 2660c. Reports on individuals designated for pur-**
2 **poses of special mission exclusion**

3 “(a) REPORTS.—Not later than one year after the
4 date of the enactment of this section, and on an annual
5 basis thereafter, the President shall submit to the Com-
6 mittees on Armed Services of the House of Representa-
7 tives and the Senate a report containing, with respect to
8 the preceding year—

9 “(1) an identification of any individual des-
10 ignated by the President for purposes of section
11 2655(12)(B)(iii) of this title; and

12 “(2) a description of how often individuals so
13 designated were transported in connection with a
14 mission that, but for such designation, would be con-
15 sidered a special mission.

1 “(b) FORM.—Each report under subsection (a) shall
2 be submitted in unclassified form, but may contain a clas-
3 sified annex.”.

Add at the end the following new section:

1 **SEC. 205. TRANSPARENCY REGARDING MIDAIR COLLISION**
2 **NEAR RONALD REAGAN WASHINGTON NA-**
3 **TIONAL AIRPORT ON JANUARY 29, 2025.**

4 (a) SUBMISSIONS TO CONGRESS.—Not later than 60
5 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Sec-
6 retary of the Army shall submit to the Committees on
7 Armed Services of the House of Representatives and the
8 Senate—

9 (1) a copy of the command investigation of the
10 midair collision that occurred near Ronald Reagan
11 Washington National Airport on January 29, 2025,
12 with redactions limited to those necessary to protect
13 the privacy of the flight crew involved; and

14 (2) an implementation plan for the rec-
15 ommendations contained therein.

16 (b) INSPECTOR GENERAL OF THE ARMY ASSESS-
17 MENT.—

18 (1) ASSESSMENT.—Not later than 120 days
19 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the In-

1 spector General of the Army shall commence an as-
2 sessment of the sufficiency of the recommendations
3 and implementation plan specified in subsection
4 (a)(2).

5 (2) REPORT.—Not later than 6 months after
6 the date of the enactment of this Act, the Inspector
7 General of the Army shall submit to the Committees
8 on Armed Services of the House of Representatives
9 and the Senate a report containing—

10 (A) the results of the assessment under
11 paragraph (1); and

12 (B) any additional recommendations by the
13 Inspector General relating to the matters so as-
14 sessed, as applicable.
