

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 8800
OFFERED BY MR. GARAMENDI OF CALIFORNIA

At the appropriate place in title X, insert the following:

1 **SEC. 10 ____ . MILITARY PREPAREDNESS ASSESSMENTS OF**
2 **MILITARY UNITS SUPPORTING CIVILIAN LAW**
3 **ENFORCEMENT FOR EXTENDED PERIODS.**

4 Section 276 of title 10, United States Code, is
5 amended—

6 (1) by inserting “(a) IN GENERAL.—” before
7 “Support”; and

8 (2) by adding at the end the following new sub-
9 section:

10 “(b) MILITARY PREPAREDNESS ASSESSMENTS.—If a
11 military unit has provided support under this chapter for
12 a period of longer than 30 days, the Secretary of Defense
13 shall submit to the Committees on Armed Services of the
14 Senate and the House of Representatives a written assess-
15 ment, not later than 14 days after the last day of the 30-
16 day period, and quarterly thereafter until the support con-
17 cludes. Each written assessment under this subsection
18 shall include each of the following:

1 “(1) A description of the civil support mission
2 for which the support is provided and the personnel
3 and equipment required to provide such support.

4 “(2) An assessment of the combat readiness of
5 each military unit involved in the provision of the
6 support, including whether any such unit has com-
7 pleted exercises at the battalion or equivalent level
8 or above;.

9 “(3) An identification of any training require-
10 ments or exercises that were modified or are ex-
11 pected to be deferred, delayed, or cancelled because
12 of the provision of the support, including training re-
13 quirements and exercises of military units other than
14 the units providing the support due to the diversion
15 of funding or other resources to the civil support
16 mission.

17 “(4) The total cost of the support provided for
18 personnel, equipment, and logistics, including a
19 breakdown by reimbursable and non-reimbursable
20 funding.”.
