

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 8800**  
**OFFERED BY MR. GARAMENDI OF CALIFORNIA**

Strike section 3111 (log 85623, relating to modifications to requirements for plutonium pit production capacity).

At the appropriate place in title XXXI, insert the following new section:

1 **SEC. 31\_\_\_ . MEASURES RELATING TO COSTS OF AND AL-**  
2 **TERNATIVES TO PLUTONIUM PIT PRODUC-**  
3 **TION REQUIREMENTS.**

4 (a) **MODIFICATIONS.**—Section 6128 of title 10,  
5 United States Code, is amended—

6 (1) in subsection (c)—

7 (A) by inserting “or, in lieu of such plan,  
8 recommendations of the Council for the modi-  
9 fication of such requirements” after “require-  
10 ments under subsection (a)”; and

11 (B) by striking “Such plan” and inserting  
12 “Any such plan”; and

13 (2) in subsection (b)—

14 (A) by striking “Not later than” and in-  
15 serting “(1) Not later than”; and

1 (B) by adding at the end the following new  
2 paragraph:

3 “(2) Not later than 180 days after the date of each  
4 certification under paragraph (1), the Comptroller General  
5 of the United States shall conduct a review of such certifi-  
6 cation.”.

7 (b) REPORT.—Not later than 180 days after the date  
8 of the enactment of this Act, the Administrator for Nu-  
9 clear Security shall submit to the congressional defense  
10 committees a report that contains the following:

11 (1) An integrated master schedule and life-cycle  
12 cost estimate for the production of war reserve plu-  
13 tonium pits in accordance with the requirements  
14 under section 6218(a) of title 10, United States  
15 Code.

16 (2) A comparison, including with respect to es-  
17 timated cost, schedule, risk to facilities, and work-  
18 force assumptions, of the following scenarios:

19 (A) The production of not less than 30 war  
20 reserve plutonium pits annually.

21 (B) The production of not less than 50  
22 war reserve plutonium pits annually.

23 (C) The production of not less than 80 war  
24 reserve plutonium pits annually.

1 (D) The production of not less than 180  
2 war reserve plutonium pits annually.

3 (3) An analysis of the potential reuse and refurbishment of war reserve plutonium pits to reduce  
4 costs and risks.

5 (c) FORM.—

6 (1) REPORT.—The report under subsection (a)  
7 shall be submitted in unclassified form but may include a classified annex.

10 (2) PUBLICATION.—Not later than 30 days  
11 after the date on which the Administrator submits  
12 the report under subsection (a), the Administrator  
13 shall make publicly available an unclassified executive  
14 summary of such report, including the cost estimates  
15 for each of the scenarios specified in subsection  
16 (a)(2).

17 (d) GAO REVIEW.—Not later than 180 days after the  
18 date on which the Administrator submits the report under  
19 subsection (a), the Comptroller General of the United  
20 states shall conduct a review of such report.
