

Amendment to H.R. 8800

In the appropriate place in the report to accompany H.R. 8800, insert the following new Directive Report Language:

Army Aviation Event and Associated Review

The committee directs the Secretary of the Army to provide a briefing to the House Committee on Armed Services not later than December 1, 2026, on the cancellation of any reviews or investigations regarding the March 28, 2025 aviation event involving aircraft assigned to the 101st Combat Aviation Brigade of Fort Campbell in the Nashville area. The brief should include the following:

(1) a description of the incident referenced, including units and equipment involved, mission designation, and a summary of flight operations recorded in flight logs;

(2) a description of airspace coordination or approval processes in connection with the referenced event, including with the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA);

(3) the cost of the flights involved;

(4) any approvals or authorizations for the referenced event;

(5) any deviations from the mission brief;

(6) any restrictions applicable to flight operations over or in proximity to residential areas and if any restrictions were violated;

(7) a list of any relevant post-event safety, administrative, or any reviews or investigations required after such event;

(8) any command-initiated safety, compliance, or operational reviews initiated in connection with the March 28, 2025, event, including its scope, initiating authority, and current status;

(9) if any review was terminated or suspended, the date of the termination, the authority that allowed for termination, any memorialization of the termination in documentation, and all persons involved in requesting such termination;

(10) an assessment of impact to readiness, including flight hours; and

(11) any corrective actions regarding training, familiarization with FAA protocols, communication of safety standards that occurred post event with the 101st Combat Aviation Brigade.
